



Athy UBU Youth Project Team Leader (35 hours per week)

The Team Leader will lead the project team to develop and implement services and interventions for young people in the locality based on their identified needs. This post is primarily based in Athy.

The successful candidate must have:

- a level 7 qualification or higher in Youth Work, Community Work, Social Studies or Social Care.
- a minimum of 3 years' experience of working in a youth work setting with 'at-risk' young people in a paid capacity.
- experience of developing positive working relationships with young people, their families and communities.
- experience of leading a team and of providing line management, support & supervision to staff/volunteers/students.
- experience of working on an inter-agency basis with a range of partners.
- a good working knowledge of the youth work sector in Ireland
- excellent interpersonal and communication skills and strong recording, writing, reporting and evaluation skills & experience.
- a willingness to work unsocial hours and a time off in lieu system.
- a full clean driving license and own transport.

In Sync is an organisation that supports employees in a variety of ways i.e. family friendly policies, flexible working arrangements, blended working; generous annual leave allowance; paid maternity leave; internal support & supervision; support for external clinical supervision; pension contributions (post probation) and, support for continuous professional development etc.

In Sync Youth & Family Services will employ the successful candidate on a 12-month fixed-term contract, renewable subject to funding, including a 6-month probationary period.
